



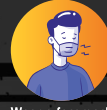

“When all famous characters came on stage together”



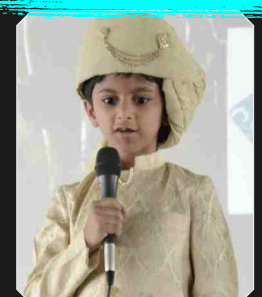

The judges panel included Aqsa Sheeraz, Syeda Sana Riyaz and Afreen Zaheer on various criteria.

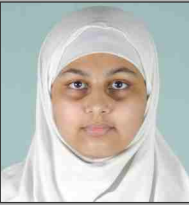
The competition brought an amiable ambiance and each participant left the stage with prolonged deafening applause.
