Lifelong learning is an integral part of IB philosophy and pedagogy. Not just for students but teachers as well. Regular opportunities for professional and personal development are a vital aspect of EPS culture. From small collaborative groups to large departmental in-house sessions to external, regional workshops by IB experts, the PYP teachers are rigorously trained to ensure a successful program implementation.

This time the focus of our in-house program-level learning was the new IB Standards and Practices. Facilitated by Junior School Principal, the four-hour-long session helped teachers understand the difference between standards, practices, and program requirements. The teachers formed groups to compare the old and the new sets of standards and presented their findings.

The session was a reflection of a dynamic IB classroom with learners developing and demonstrating an array of skills and attitudes along with the construction of knowledge and sharing experiences.

IBAP Workshop Evidencing Learning held at EPS

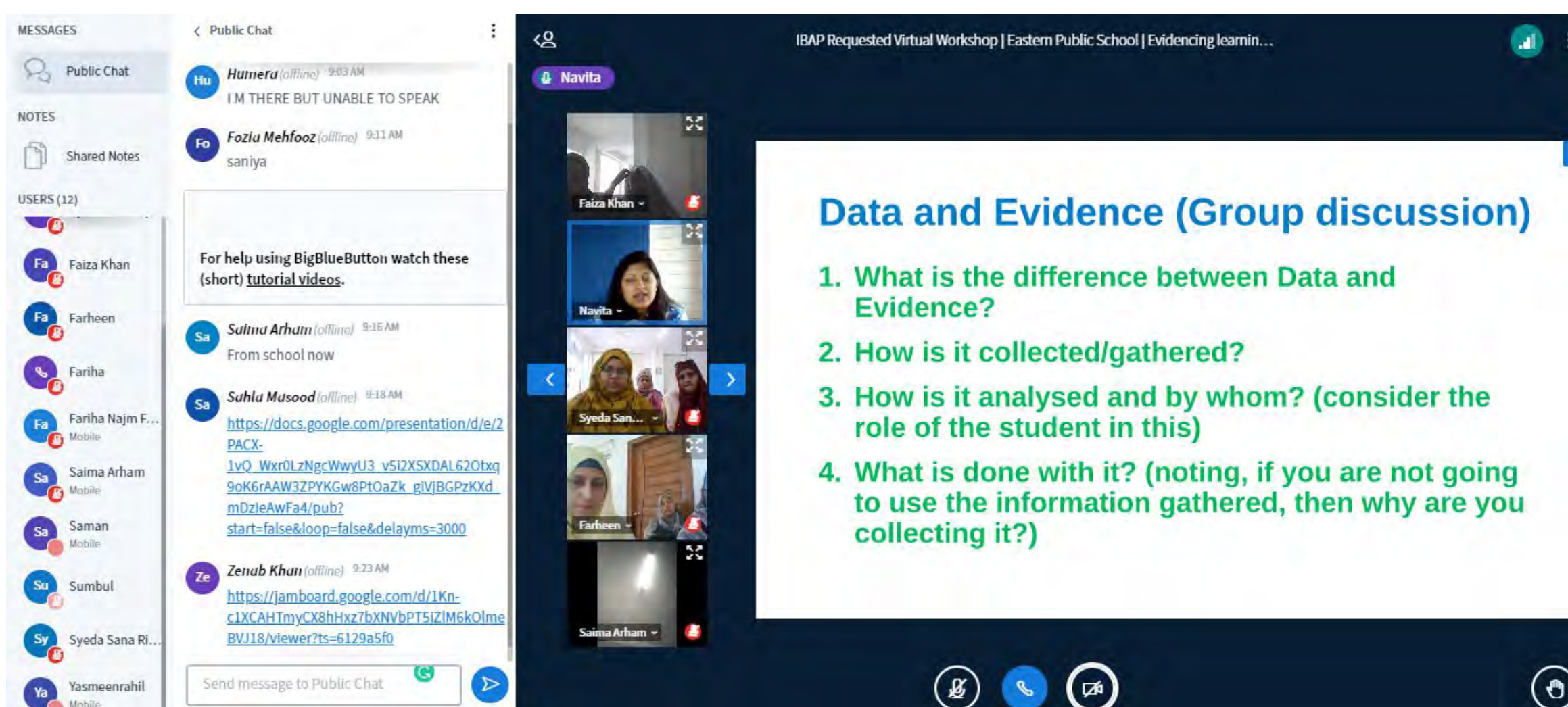
Eastern Public School organized a two-day Category 2 workshop on Evidencing Learning. The purpose of this workshop was the professional development of teachers in terms of evidencing students' learning in a more effective way.

There were many tools and strategies used to conduct the workshop. The synchronous and asynchronous sessions were established and the team was divided into breakout sessions to perform various tasks.

Through a systematic way, the 4 dimensions of evidence learning (monitoring/ documenting/ measuring and reporting) was discussed. After discussion, the major takeaway was that we focus more on documenting and reporting of evidence rather than monitoring them.

Various articles and personas were discussed with possible solutions and it was agreed that a co-constructed approach should be adopted instead of backward planning. We looked into the efficacy of feedback and feedforward and how students should be a part of planning, learning and even assessment. It was a fruitful session and we look forward to incorporating the learning in our teaching and learning.

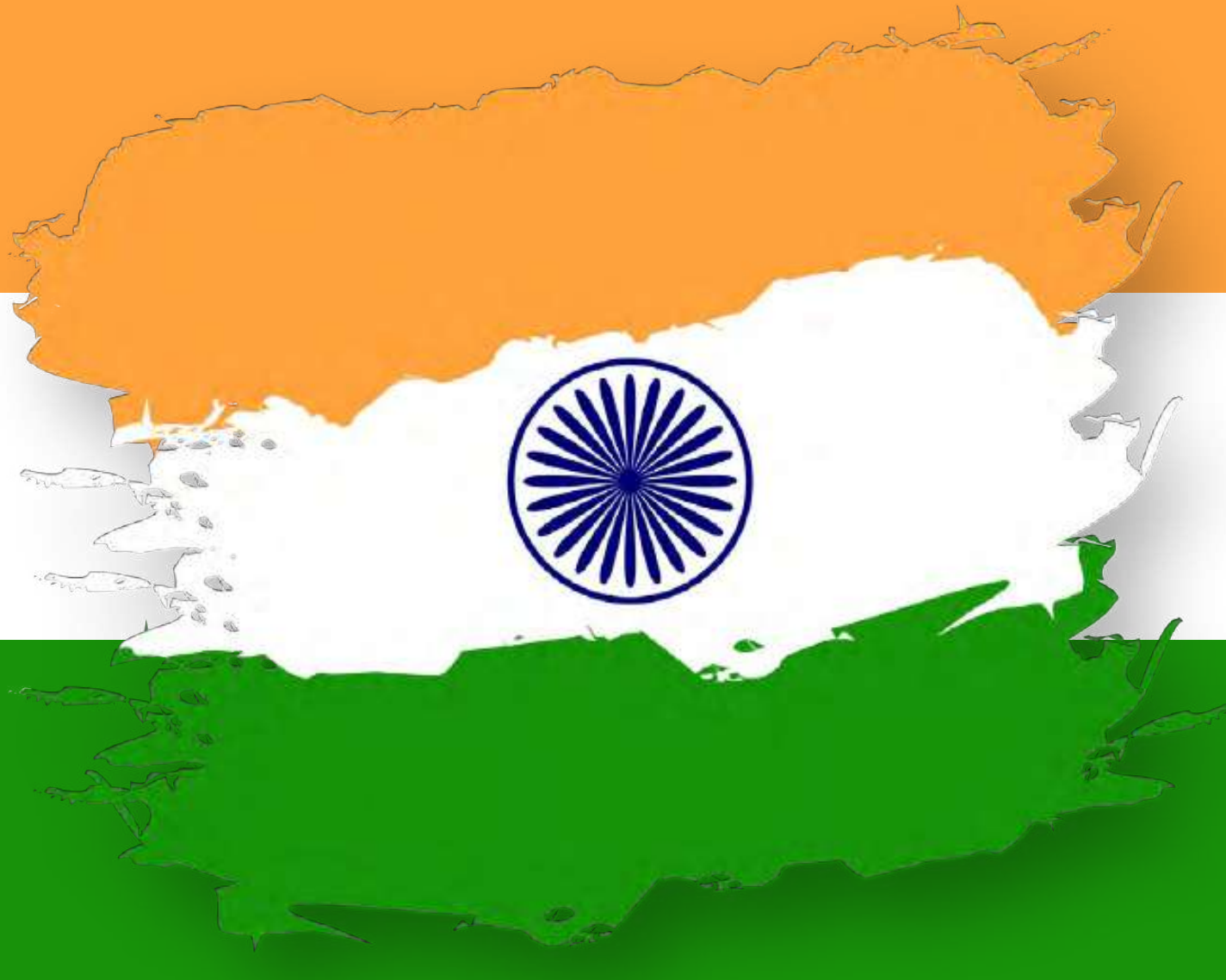
