#### **ADMISSION CRITERIA**

Prophet Mohammed (peace be upon him) said: "Gaining knowledge is obligatory for every Muslim man and woman"! So, EPS was set up with the sole objective of providing world-class education which benefits our students in Dunya and Aakhirah.

Admission is a carefully thought-through process at EPS. We do not cater to any specific section of society except in order to preserve our core-values. The final decision of admission will solely rest with the school management.

#### **ADMISSION PROCESS**

- 1. Parents receive, fill and submit the Admission Inquiry Form, with the child's personal details.
- 2. The Admission Officer shares the complete fee structure and information regarding the offered programmes and responds to other queries.
- 3. After the initial scrutiny and consent by management, parents receive an Application/Registration Form and prospective syllabus to be assessed [on request] for the grade entrance.
- 4. Parents are asked to bring their ward to school for the Competency Level Assessment (CLA) on the scheduled date and time. For PYP grades the CLA is supervised by primary years teachers.
- 5. Assessment copies are reviewed by specialist teachers, Grade Level Coordinator and Programme Coordinator and finally by the management for approval.
- 6. The decision of allowing admission is based on the results and the parents' commitment and attitude.
- 7. Status of the admission request is communicated to parents within a week.
- 8. Parents are requested to proceed with the submission of requisite documents and fees payment according to the fee structure of the year of entrance.

#### SIBLING POLICY

The management will grant admissions to siblings of existing students with following considerations:



1st **Child** - Full Payment of Registration, Admission, Tuition, Transport, Activity Fee and Caution Money.



2<sup>nd</sup> **Child** - Registration Free + 50% Off on Admission Fee but full payment of all other fees and Caution Money.



**3rd Child** - Registration Free + No Admission Fee but full payment of all other fees and Caution Money.

#### NOTES:

- 1. Tuition and Transport Fee is to be paid for 4 quarters.
- [1. April-June 2. July-September 3. October-December 4. January-March]
- 2.Tuition Fee is payable for 12 months\* whereas the Transport Fee will be charged for 11 months.

[No transportation charges for the month of May]

- 3. Transport Fee varies depending upon the distance from the school + a fixed cost for a seat.
- 4. Tuition Fee is to be paid from April to March, regardless of the month of admission.
- 5. The guarterly fee is to be paid within the first 10 days of each guarter.
- \*For Nursery the Tuition Fee is charged for 9 months only.
- \*For Diploma Programme (DP) Grade 12th the Tuition Fee is charged for 14 months.
