


## **ISP MISSION STATEMENT**

# BALANCED APPROACH

We emphasize a framework that integrates Haqooq-ul-Allah (rights of the Creator) and Haqooq-ul-Ibad (rights of creation), fostering academic growth and moral excellence. Our curriculum nurtures students to build a strong relationship with Allah while understanding their responsibilities towards fellow human beings.

## ENGAGING AND INTERACTIVE LEARNING

Through engaging lessons, real-life examples, and interactive activities, students are encouraged to internalize the pillars of Islam and the Islamic Learner Profiles. They practice these values within the school and extend them into the wider community. Our teaching methodology prioritizes mentoring and counseling, providing personalized guidance to support each student's personal growth and well-being.









## SUBJECTS OFFERED AT EPS-ISP

#### 1. Hifz

- Focus: Memorization of the 30th Juz of the Quran.
- Purpose: To deeply understand the central idea of Islamic Faith i.e. accountability of our small and big actions on the Day of Judgement.

#### 2. Tafseer

- Focus: In-depth study of the meanings and teachings of the memorized Surahs
- Purpose: The concept of Tawheed, Risalat and Akhirat is repeatedly
  emphasized to strengthen Iman in our students. Students engage with
  Surahs of Juz Amma to clarify the central idea of our deen i.e. Akhirat.

## 3. Islamic Studies

- Focus: A comprehensive study of Iman, Akhlaq, Ibadah, and Islamic history within a coherent framework.
- Purpose: To strengthen the foundation of our Deen and build the character through the integration of Islamic Learner Profiles.

## ISLAMIC DRESS CODE FOR STAFF AND STUDENTS

At EPS we follow a Universal Islamic dress code:

- Modest, neat and tidy clothes that cover the body as advised in our Deen.
- Full-length outfits made of decent, thick/non-transparent fabric and design.
- Head scarf is mandatory for all the Muslim female-staff members and girls.
- Men should lower their gaze and guard their modesty.
